# 4 Major State and Local Fund Types Support Our Schools

- 1) Minimum Foundation Program - \$3,961 per student enrolled. \*MFP formula submitted annually to the Legislature by SBESE. Same amount of funding since 14-15 school year.
- 2) Sales Tax - \$2,041 per student enrolled. TPSS ranks 37<sup>th</sup> out of 69 districts
- 3) Property Tax - \$397 per student enrolled. TPSS ranks 69<sup>th</sup> out of 69 districts
- 4) Other Revenue (timber sales, summer school tuition, interest, etc.) - \$40 per student enrolled. TPSS ranks 44<sup>th</sup> out of 69 districts.



\*Hammond pays an additional 15 mills for the Hammond Accelerated Magnet Programs and an additional 3 mills for the Hammond Alternative Programs:  
 Magnet Tax generates \$ 762.59 per student enrolled  
 Hammond Alternative Tax generates \$ 150.93 per student enrolled.

**Tangipahoa Parish ranks 69 out of 69 school districts in the state in total revenue per pupil at just \$9,683.00. Total revenue includes federal, state, and local revenues.**
